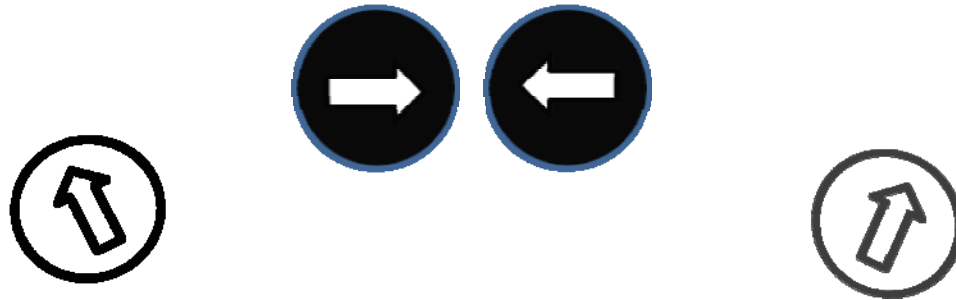


When the relief guards reach
the mark the current guards
come to attention





The relief guards angle to the corners of the casket and the current guards face each other and meet in the center



As the relief guards reach the corner of the casket the current guards face the casket as they step in line

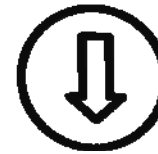


This

All guards About face together



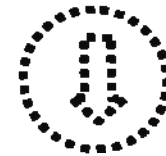
This side

When the outgoing guards reach
the mark the new guards take one
side step out and then
go to ceremonial rest – see next
slide





Ceremonial rest can be straight or at a 45 degree angle, EVERYONE must do it the same way what ever you decide during practice

When you step out to go to ceremonial rest the two guards should now be spaced equally from the corners of the casket
