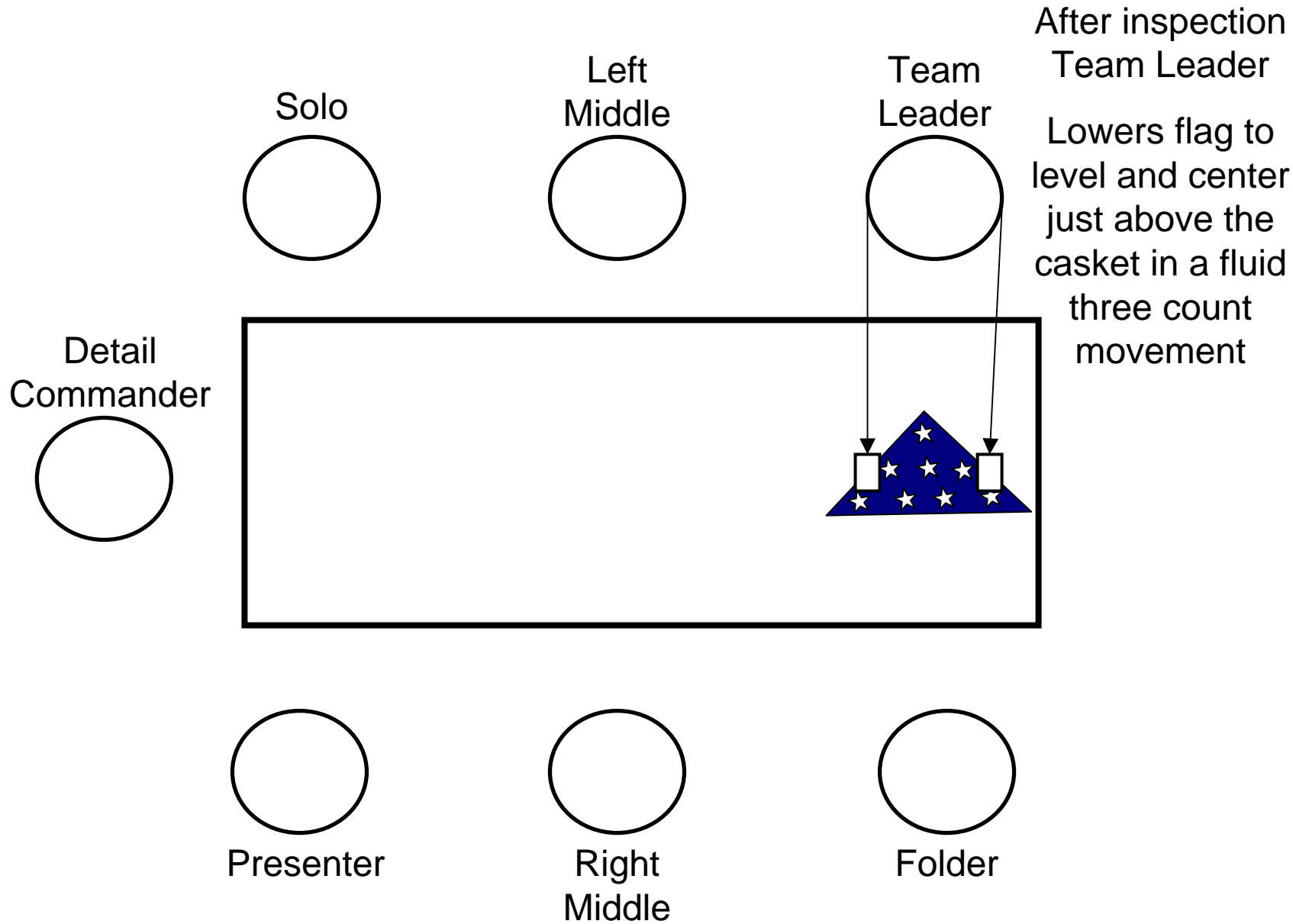


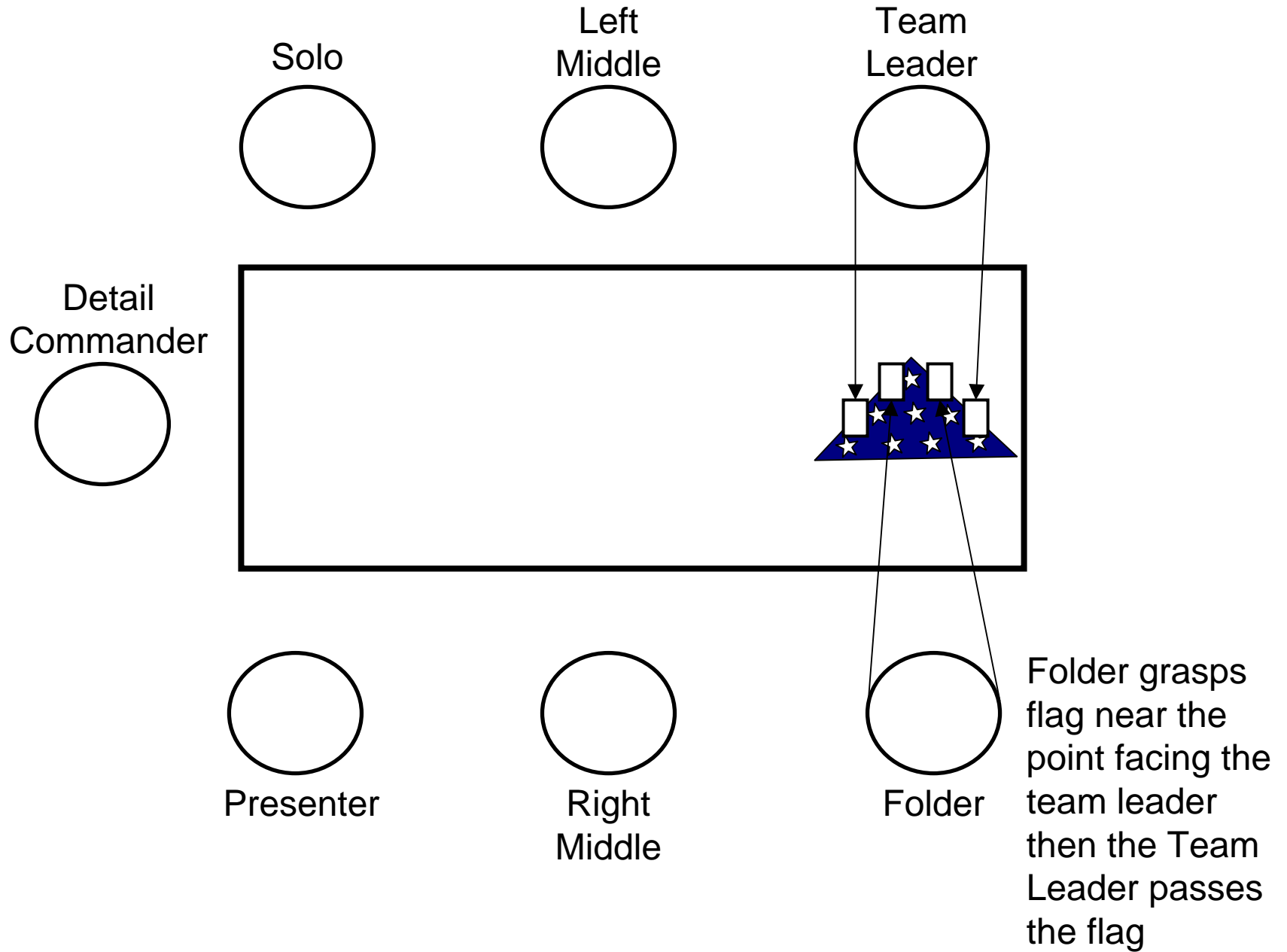


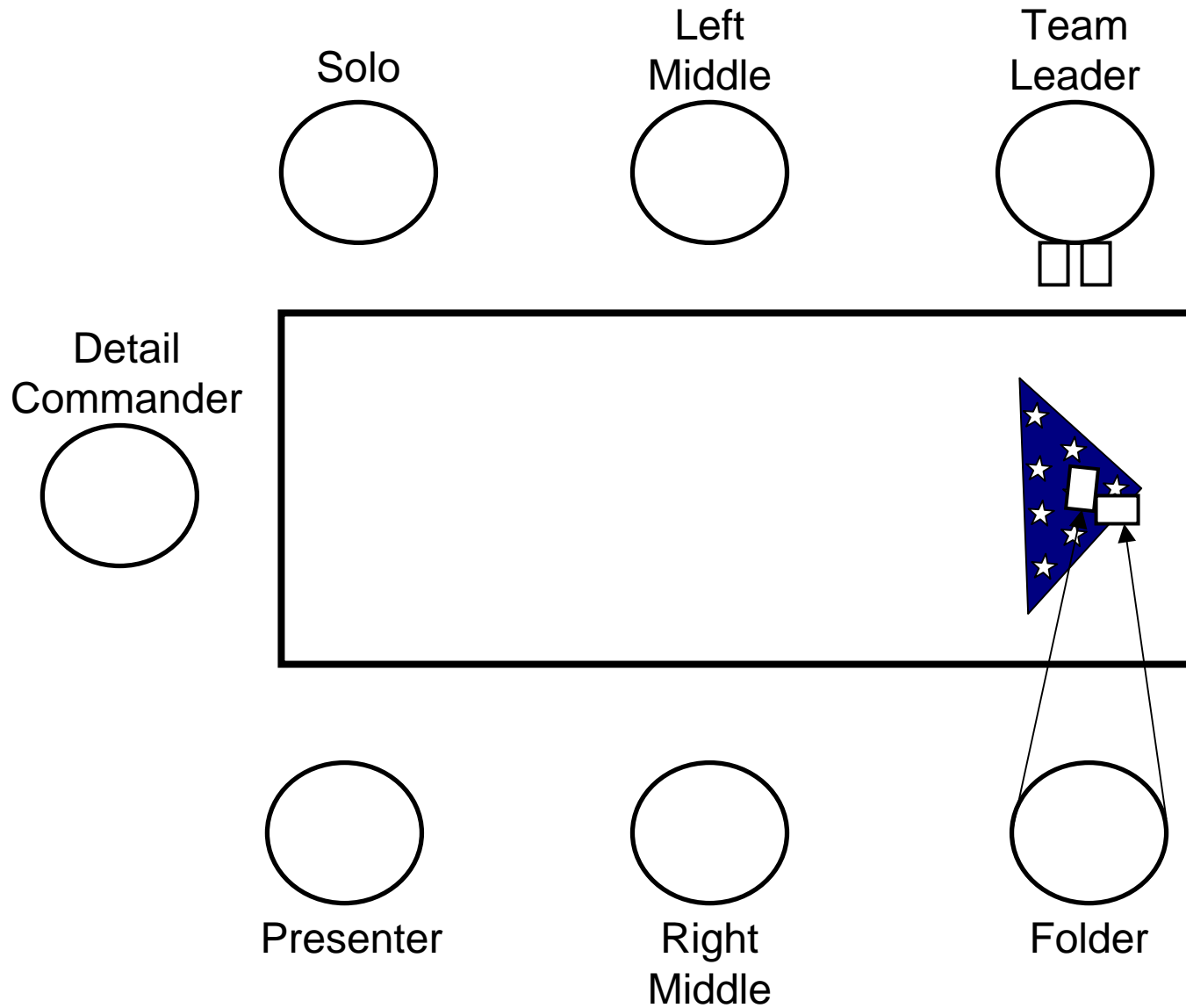
After the fold is complete the Team Leader brings flag vertical against the uniform center then slides hands out under the sides of the flag near the corners and holds the flag for inspection.

NOTE the flag is held still in this position for inspection and/or adjustment.

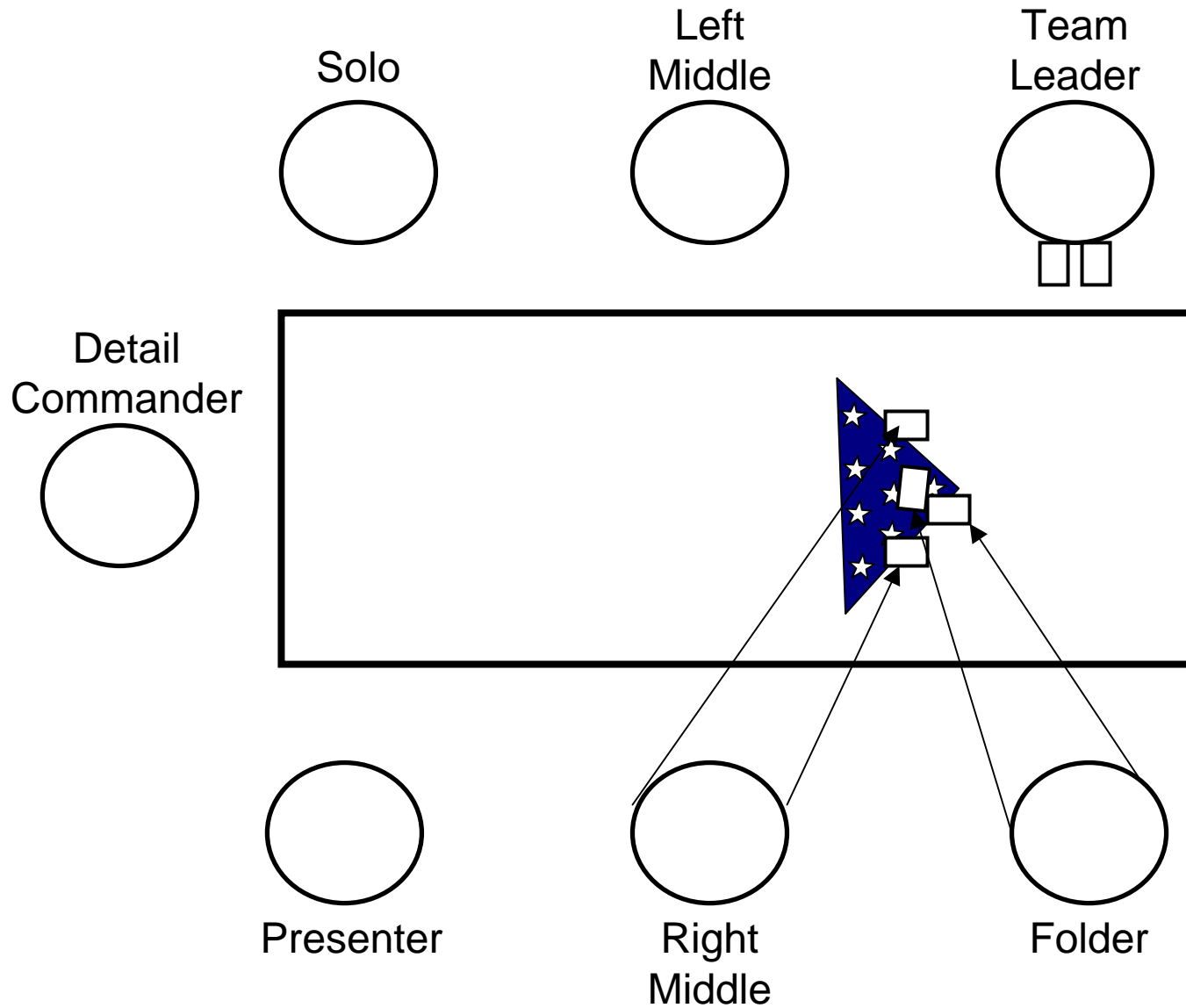
Folder looks at any part of the flag that needs dressed or at the center if it is ok.



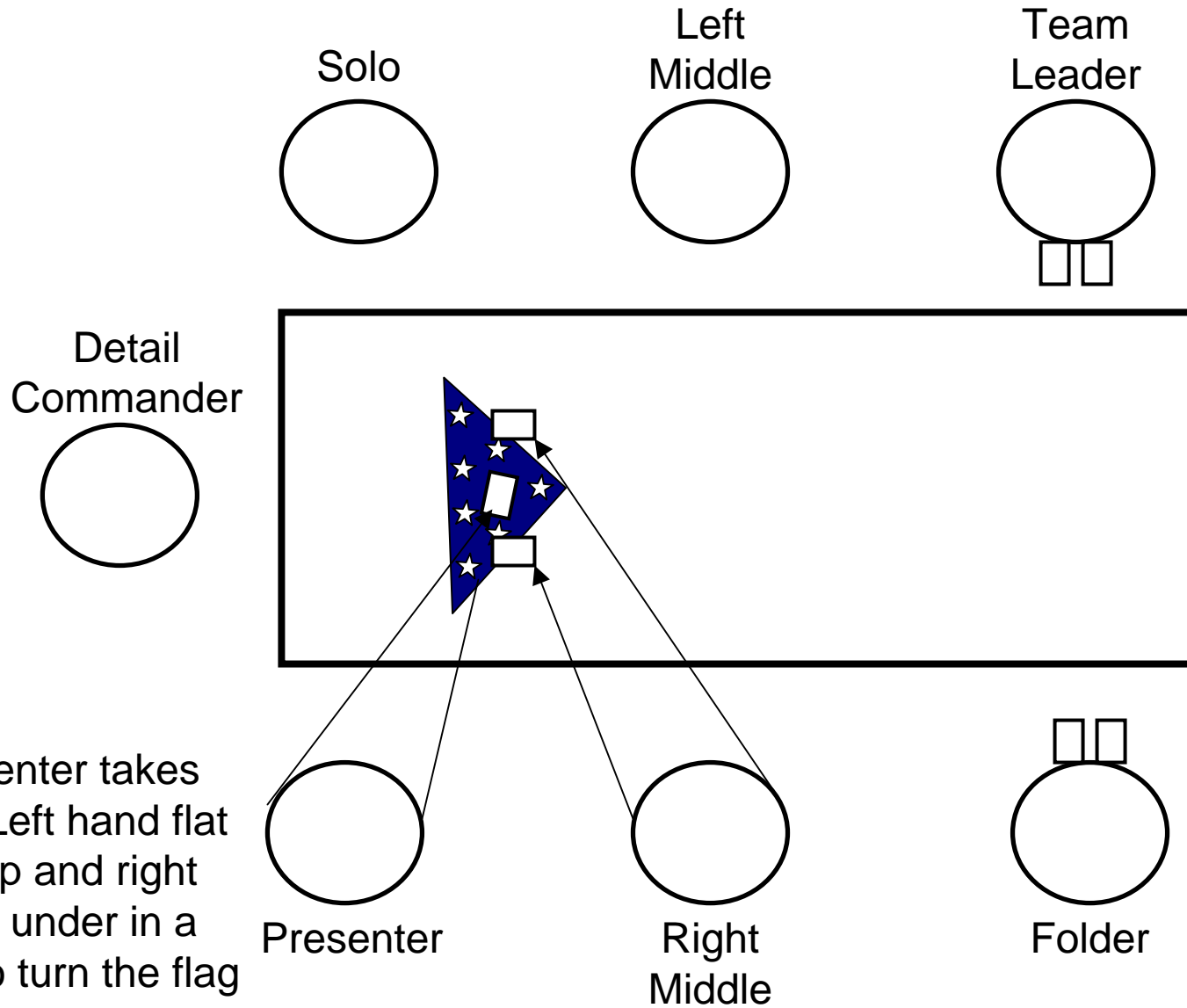

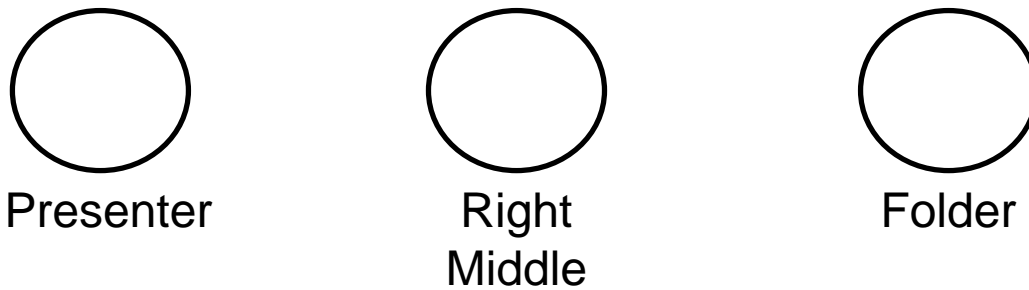
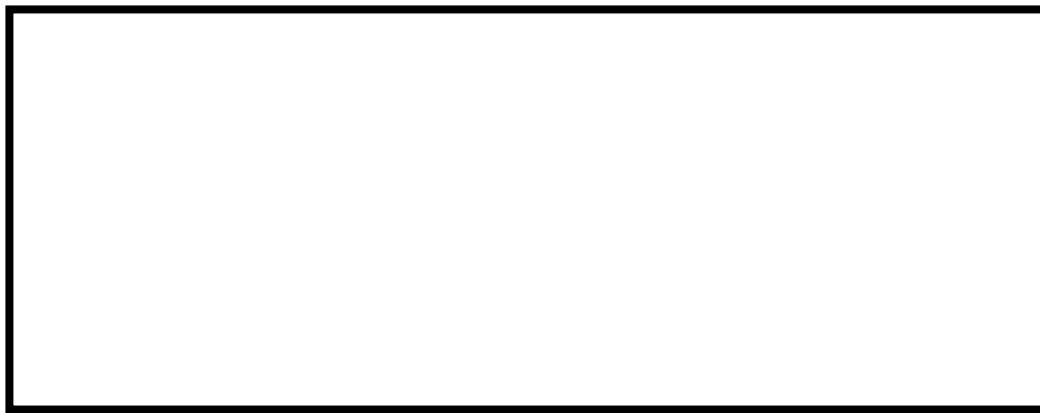
The Detail Commander then presents the flag to someone to deliver it to the family or the Detail Commander presents it to the family.

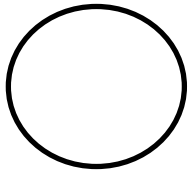


The Detail Commander returns to the casket and posts at the head end facing the casket.
